The Town of Arlington... Our History



WHO WAS GENERAL SAMUEL J. HAYS?

Samuel Jackson Hays (1804-1866), became the ward of his uncle, Andrew Jackson, upon the death of Samuel's father, Colonel Robert Hays, and President Jackson was a great influence on Samuel's life. Samuel Hays attended West Point Military Academy, at age 23 served as his uncle's secretary in the White House and was a Major General in the 2nd Army of Tennessee in the Mexican War. General Hays purchased a tract of 640 acres from the State of Tennessee in 1837 that eventually became known as Haysville (also referred to as Wythe Depot with the development of the Memphis and Ohio Railroad). By 1845, Hays, who had never lived in Haysville (later Arlington), sold much of his property in the area (Burrow 1962).

met the challenge of blending old and new. Today's leaders are tasked with providing its citizens with the modern conveniences and infrastructure they require, all the while, preserving the influences of the past that make Arlington unique.

In 2014, with wide community support and effort, Arlington Community Schools was created, and ACS is credited as one of Arlington's most desirable assets. Many families move to Arlington to access the schools but find that they also access a rich and deep history in our Town.

When future generations look back at Arlington's history, no doubt they will reminisce about when the Forrest Street Park was built and when Arlington gained a Tennis Center, along with other recent improvements. Hopefully, with good planning, they will see that our Town leaders added great amenities for our citizens while protecting Arlington's rich history.

The land currently known as Arlington originally belonged to the Chickasaw Indians. In 1818, a Treaty with the Chickasaw ceded this land, along with other land in West Tennessee, to the United States. On November 24, 1819, Shelby County was established and named after Isaac Shelby, who

was one of the commissioners of the Treaty with the Chickasaw, a Revolutionary War Veteran and the first governor of Kentucky. During this time, the community consisted of



fewer than 20 settlers.

By 1856, the community had grown to around 200. Agriculture was predominant in the area, and a method of shipping was essential. As a result, Withe Depot was constructed on land donated by General Samuel J. Hays. Served by the Memphis & Ohio Railroad, the primary shipment was cotton and its purpose was to attract shipping to the Fayette County community of Withe. Because of this generous donation of land by General Hays, the community was named Haysville, which continued its growth until the Civil War, when men answered the call to fight the war. Many never returned.

In 1872, the land surrounding Withe Depot owned by the Estate of General Hays was sold off, and the lots sold at a public sale with an ad stating "its healthy location, finest agricultural region, churches, schools, and railroad

makes it one of the most desirable points for business and residences."

Haysville was incorporated on February 10, 1878. W. B. Nolley served as Mayor, followed by H.Y. Marley, Dr. J.P. Bone, W.I. Hooks, and C.C. Poole. During this time, an outbreak of yellow fever prompted the Town fathers to quarantine Haysville. Outsiders were not allowed to enter in an attempt to mitigate the spread of the deadly fever.

In 1883, Town leaders wanted to establish a post office. However, a "Haysville" post office already existed in Tennessee. Captain Henry Pitman suggested that the town change its name to "Arlington," after Arlington National Cemetery in Virginia. The population stood at 500, and the Town proudly boasted its own steam sawmill, grist mill, steam cotton gin, livery stable, stores, and four churches. By the end of the 19th Century, the Town had added a post office, physician, druggist, lumber store, meat market, and an undertaker.

In 1900, with a population of around 600, the Town of Arlington was incorporated. Some of the early citizens to serve as Mayor were Will Taylor, Charles McAuley, C.W. Bond, Sam Tucker Wilson, and Jimmy Henry. The 1950 census shows only 465 residents, and the 1960 census lists 651. In its centennial year (2000), Arlington was home to approximately 2,300 people. The special census of 2018 lists Arlington with a population of just under 14,000 citizens, making our Town one of the fastest growing communities in Tennessee.

Throughout its history, Arlington has

We also have a wonderful library and senior center, which are both very active and offer a variety of options for all

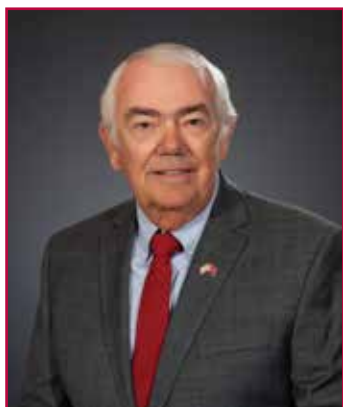
ages and interests. These are the things I believe truly make this a great place to live and raise a family. We're proud to offer this quality of life, and we invite you to sample our small-town charm!

WHAT IS STORMWATER?

Stormwater is the water that lands on our lawns, driveways, and roads during a rain or snowstorm. Water can't soak into our driveways or roads, so this water flows into storm drains, which are the inlets you see on the side of the roads. Stormwater is also carried through drainage channels/ditches along the side of the roads.

Stormwater is of concern for two main issues: one related to the volume and timing of runoff water (flood control and water supplies), or QUANTITY, and the other related to potential contaminants that the water is carrying, i.e. water pollution, or QUALITY. Polluted stormwater runoff can have negative effects on plants, fish, animals, and people.

What can you do?

- Keep all drainage swales open and clear of debris. Do not modify them.
- Do not wash paints, solvents, or other household cleaners into storm drains.
- Prevent detergent and oils from your vehicle from entering the storm drain.
- Keep lawn waste, fertilizer, and pesticides from washing into the drains.
- Be careful when directing runoff toward your neighbor. You could be held liable in civil court if it is proven that you damaged your neighbor's property.
- Ask questions before changing drainage around your home. Check with your HOA or Town employees prior to making changes.

AFD Celebrates 70 Years - 1949-2019

Arlington established a worthy fire department in 1949 with the purchase of a new Ford truck with central fire-fighting equipment, including ladders, hose, and a 500-gallon booster tank. This truck was stored under a shed at S.Y. Wilson's store for several months, as there was no firehouse.

The department was all volunteer, providing limited fire protection and basic medical services to approximately 463 residents. The old station, that they moved into in 1950, has long been razed, but the department still has possession of their first fire engine which was purchased in the late summer of 1950 from the Central Fire Truck Corporation for \$5,634.00. In comparison, Engine 71 was purchased in 2013 for \$550,000.00. The department operates out of Fire Station No. 1 but protects 28 times the citizenry today!

Not since Fire Station No. 1 was built in 1980 has AFD experienced the growth that is currently underway. Fire Station No. 2 will be completed in late 2020, and AFD has added a second company of firefighters (12) in



preparation for moving into the new station. Also, a Quint with pump and tank capabilities was added to the equipment in 2019. The new apparatus has a 107 ft. ladder, 1500 gpm pump, and a 500-gallon tank. Once the new station is completed, the Quint will stay at Station No. 1 and the engine will move to Station No. 2.

Under an agreement dating back to 1995, Arlington operates in an automatic aid agreement with the Shelby County Fire Department. The agreement remains in effect today as the AFD provides automatic aid to the Shelby County Fire Department and vice versa.

In 2015, AFD hired their first 3 EMTs, allowing the department to provide advanced life support. The department continues to strive to be one of the best and highest qualified departments in the county. Members of AFD have become state certified Instructors, Inspectors, Officers and members of the FEMA US & R Team, TN-TF-1. They are ready whenever needed due to continuous education and training.

The Shelby County Sheriff's Office (SCSO), under the leadership of Shelby County Sheriff Floyd Bonner, Jr., is a full-service law enforcement agency and the pre-trial custodial keeper of those who break the law. It is the mission of the Shelby County Sheriff's Office to protect the lives and property of the citizens of Shelby County, Tennessee, to preserve the peace, to maintain a safe and secure jail, and to prevent crime and disorder while constantly guarding personal liberties as prescribed by law.

And while the Sheriff's Office serves all residents of Shelby County, with the substation located in the Town of Arlington (which opened in 2002), there is a real concentration of law enforcement in our community – which is a great benefit to Arlington. "We have a great working relationship with the SCSO substation headquarters in Arlington," explains Mayor Mike Wissman. "Many of the officers live in our community, so this is their home, too. They know our kids, and they want our homes and schools to be safe. We are fortunate to have them located here – it is a tremendous asset for Arlington." The Sheriff's Office substation is home to a number of divisions including Uniform Patrol, Traffic, DUI, Community Operations, Vehicle Maintenance, and School Resource Officers.

School Resource Officers (SRO's) serve in the schools throughout Shelby County, including Arlington Community Schools. Deputies are assigned to both Arlington High School and Arlington Middle School. Through mentoring, example, and education, these officers teach students of the dangers associated with drugs and alcohol, criminal activity, and other anti-social behavior.

"The Town of Arlington is near and dear to my heart," said Sheriff Bonner.

"For nearly 20 years, residents and town officials have welcomed our deputies and other SCSO employees into the community. For that, I will always be grateful," he said. SCSO, we salute you – thank you for serving our community!

Sam T. Wilson Public Library Promotes Learning

Since 2005, the Sam T. Wilson Public Library, previously known as the Arlington Branch Library, has been fully owned and operated by the Town of Arlington. Library staff is guided by policies developed by the Sam T. Wilson Library Board, composed of seven citizens appointed by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen. The library strives to:

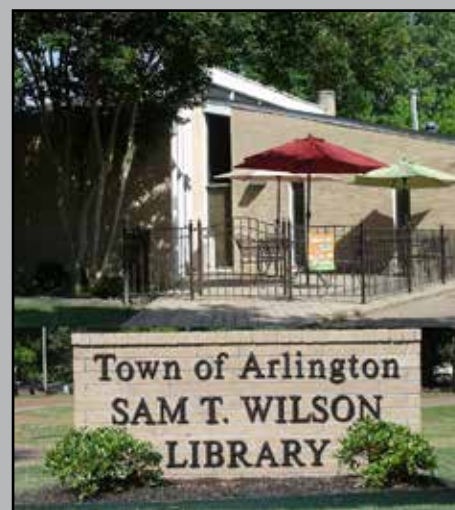
- Promote lifelong learning and a love of reading
- Inform, enrich, and empower every patron served
- Provide easy access to a wide variety of materials, services, and programs
- Meet the personal, educational, cultural, and professional information needs of the community

Residents, students who attend an ACS school, active military personnel, and property owners within the town limits of Arlington are entitled to a free library card. Those who live outside the town limits may obtain a library card for an annual fee of \$50; senior non-resident library cards are available for a discounted annual rate of \$25. All library cards must be renewed annually.

The Arlington Branch Library was renamed by the Arlington Library Board as the Sam T. Wilson Public Library in honor of the late, Sam T. Wilson, who served as the Town's mayor from 1970 to 1986. Besides his lifelong dedication to the community and its citizens, Mayor Sam was also a decorated World War II veteran. He ran the Town's general merchandise store, S.Y. Wilson, started by his grandfather in 1893.

SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER

PROVIDES SOCIAL ACTIVITIES AND LEARNING

The Arlington Senior Citizens Center opened in the fall of 2003 to serve as a gathering place for Arlington's Senior Citizens. The building is a replica of Arlington's original railroad depot station from the late 1800's known as "Withe Depot." Seniors, ages 50 and over, meet at the center to enjoy various activities such as: bingo, balance exercises, potlucks, sing-a-longs, sewing classes and quilting, scrapbooking, book clubs, and coffees. Besides these activities, it is important for seniors to stay up to date on topics that affect them in these ever-changing times. Healthy Living 101 offers free "Lunch and Learn" programs in health, safety, technology, finance, and art. Each month, a new engaging and informative speaker visits with the group.

Preserving Our History Makes Today Stronger

Association for the Preservation of Tennessee Antiquities, Arlington Chapter

The Association for the Preservation of Tennessee Antiquities (APTA) is a statewide nonprofit historic preservation organization established in 1951. The Arlington Chapter, chartered on May 21, 1979, promotes and preserves Arlington history through five historic sites maintained by the Chapter and through community activities and events. If you are interested in joining the Arlington Chapter or for more information email APTA.arlington.tn@gmail.com. These sites are maintained by Arlington's APTA and are opened during special events and by appointment:

RACHEL H.K. BURROW MUSEUM

Located at the corner of Chester and Walker streets, the building was originally built as the Arlington Bank & Trust in 1905.

Afterwards, the building also served as a dance studio, medical office, library, and beginning in 1960, as Town Hall (until the present Town Hall on Airline Road was dedicated in 1980). The museum currently displays local historical items and special exhibits.



HISTORIC POST OFFICE

Located in Depot Square on Chester Street, the Post Office was built around 1900. It was the first post office building in Arlington and its original location was in a row of

businesses that faced the railroad track. The historic post office currently displays postal items and other memorabilia. (Extra credit...the building at 11974 Walker Street,

next to the library, also served Arlington as a post office, prior to the present post office on Airline Road.)



HARRELL FARM LOG CABIN

Located in Depot Square on Chester Street, the log cabin dates to the mid-1800's and was used as a cook's kitchen on the Harrell Farm before the turn of the century. The



little cabin was moved into town in 1921 and continued to be used as a cook's house. In 1991, Miss Addie Lee Harrell, offered to let the Arlington volunteer

firemen burn the cabin down to practice their skills. The quick action of a member of the APTA saved the cabin, and APTA members dismantled the cabin and moved it to its current location. A rope bed and other period pieces are displayed in the cabin.

BLACKSMITH SHOP

Located in Depot Square on Quintard Street, the Black-



smith Shop is a reconstruction of the original building that collapsed in 1991. The shop displays blacksmithing tools and old farm equipment and contains one of the few working

forges in Tennessee. Demonstrations are held during special events.

HOLY INNOCENTS CEMETERY

Located at 11915 Campbell Street, Holy Innocents Cemetery is the final resting spot for many of Arlington's founders. The cemetery was established in 1881 with the burial of a young child. The Holy Innocents Church was built on the property in 1882. In 1883, Ephraim Edward and Sarah Louisa Butler Greenlee deeded the one-acre lot with the church building and cemetery to the Protestant Episcopal Church Diocese of Tennessee. The church building was dismantled in 1929, and the last burial in the cemetery occurred in 1987. In 2003, the Diocese of West Tennessee deeded the property to the APTA. In 2017, an open-air replica of the Holy Innocents Church was built on site using the original church windows and featuring the old church steps.

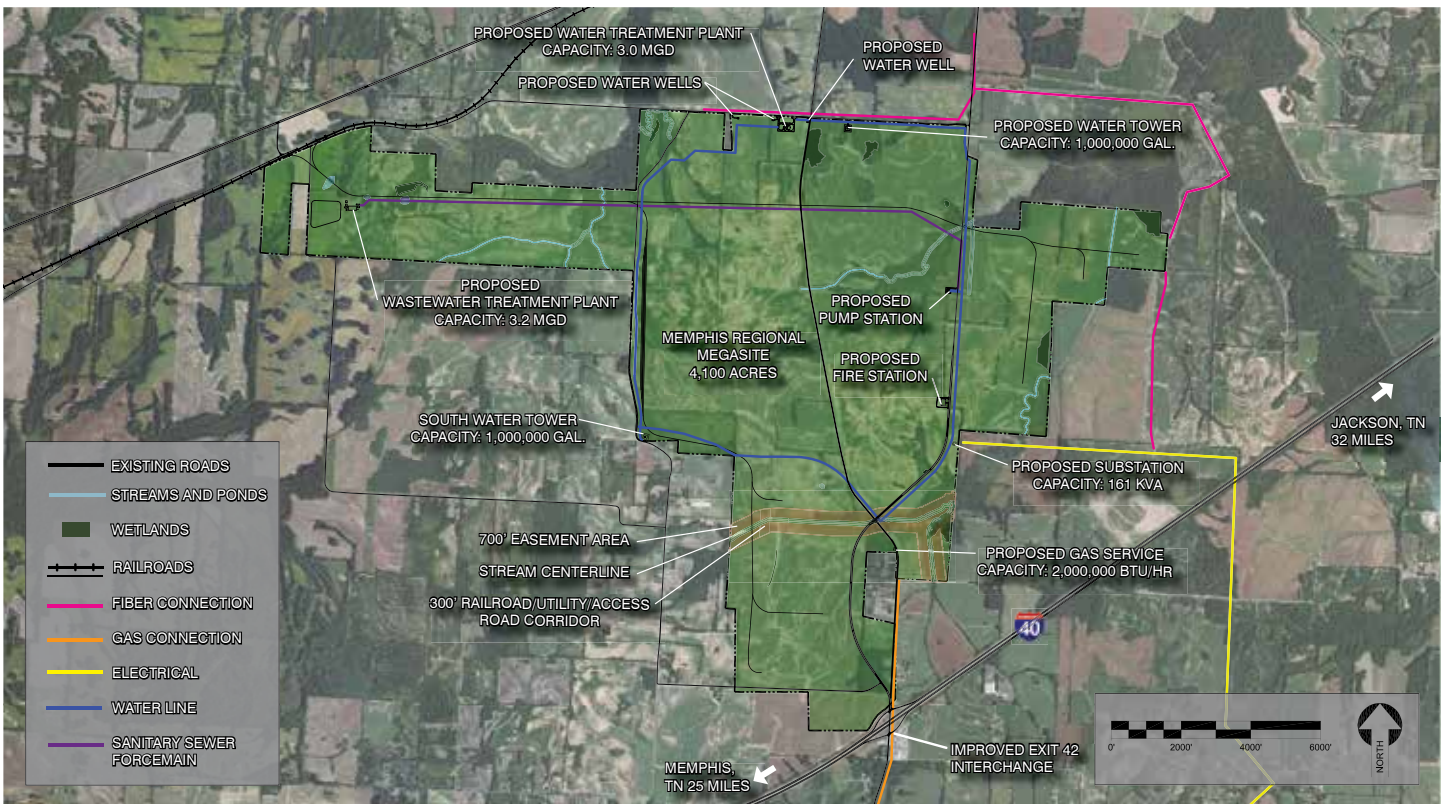

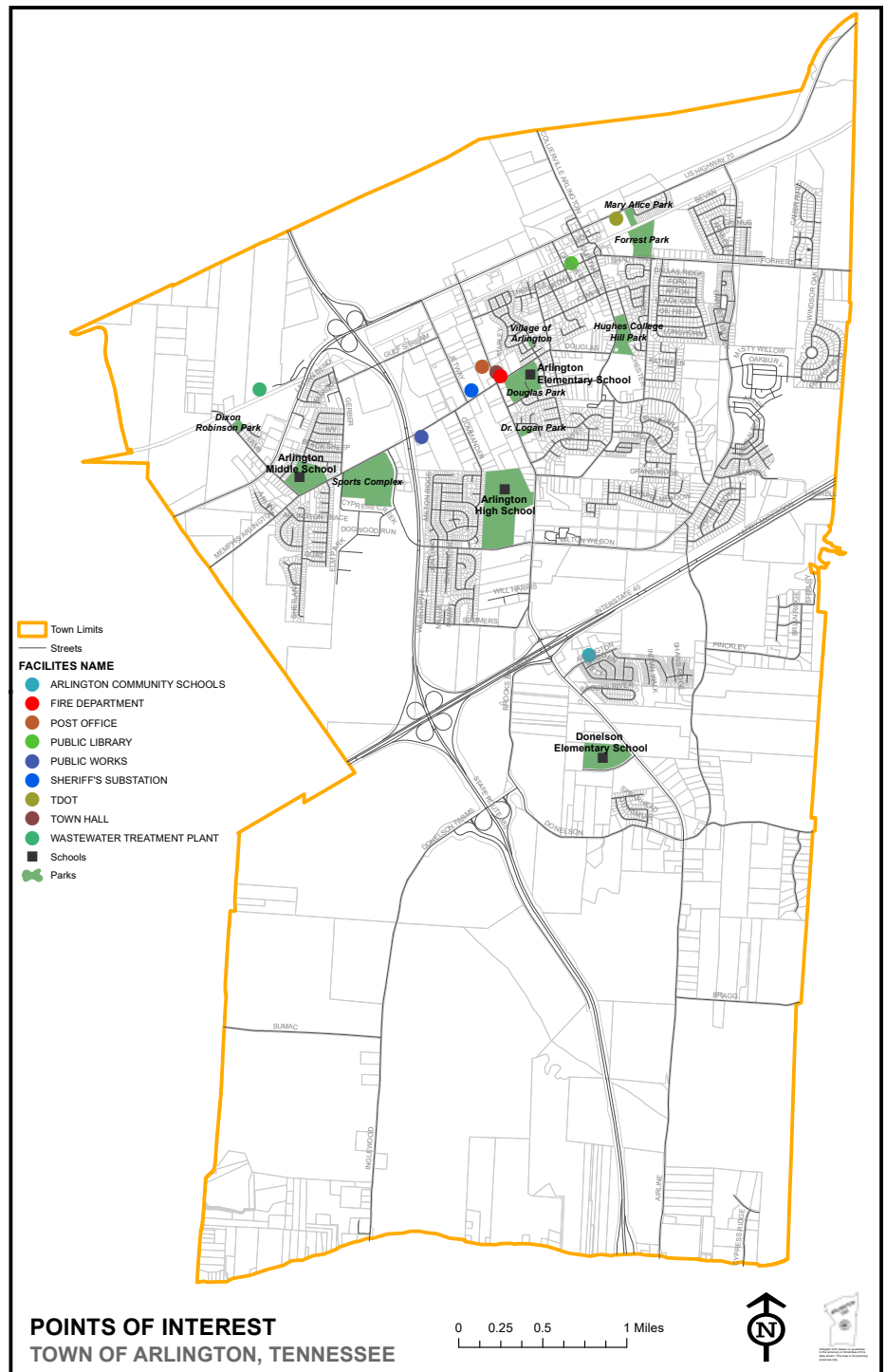

Educating more than 850 students, AES is led by Principal Anna Jones, who began her role in the 2015-2016 school year. Ms. Jones is honored to lead the school as they continue their journey on the road to success. AES boasts an average classroom size well below the state average

(19-24:1). Fifty-four percent of AES' staff has an advanced degree and more than 70 percent has 10 or more years of experience working in education.

AES believes school should be more than just academics. It should also foster relationship building, connect students to other ideas and cultures, and most importantly, it should be fun. That's why AES is proud to offer nearly 25 clubs and organizations that stimulate the brain and help connect students with similar interests, from an award-winning Lego Robotics club to Spanish and photography clubs.

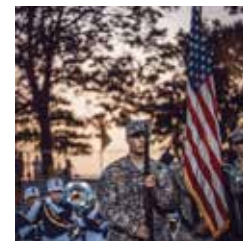
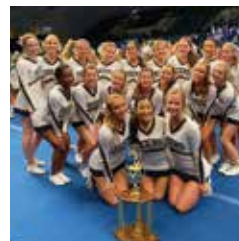

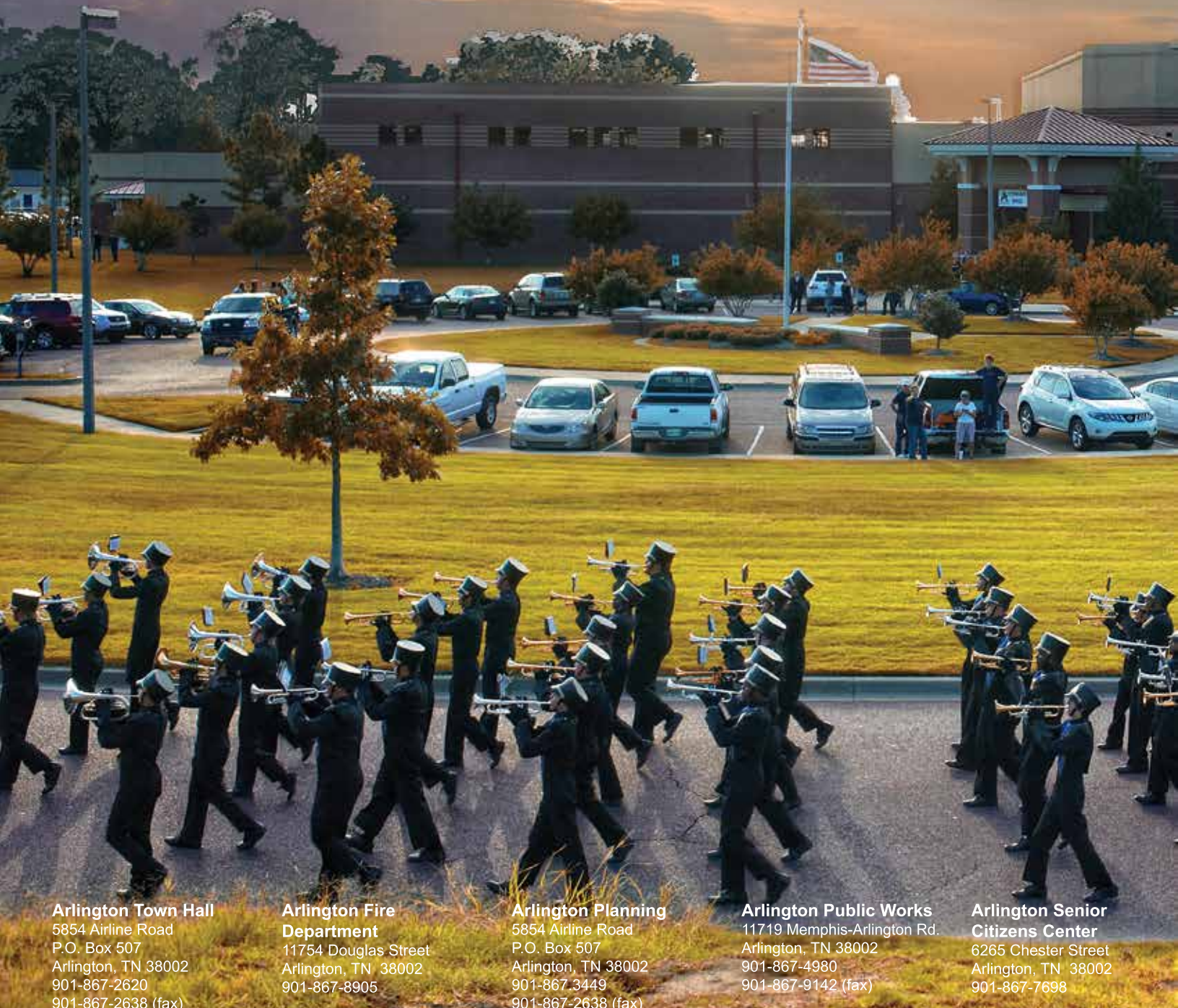
